# **BOLOGNA PROCESS implementation in Moldova**




#### Distribution of students by levels (Bachelor & Master)

Republic of Moldova joined Tempus in 1994. From 1994 to 2013 83 projects (including pre-projects), worth in total 43 mln Euro, were implemented.

## **Capacity Building in Higher Education**

The first CBHE projects that involved Higher Education Institutions from Moldova have been selected in 2015. The first project to be coordinated by a Moldovan HEI was selected in 2016.
