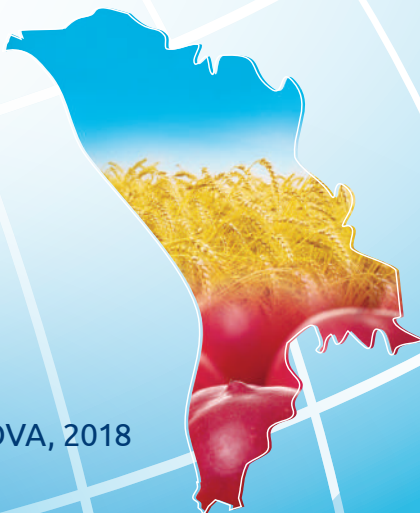

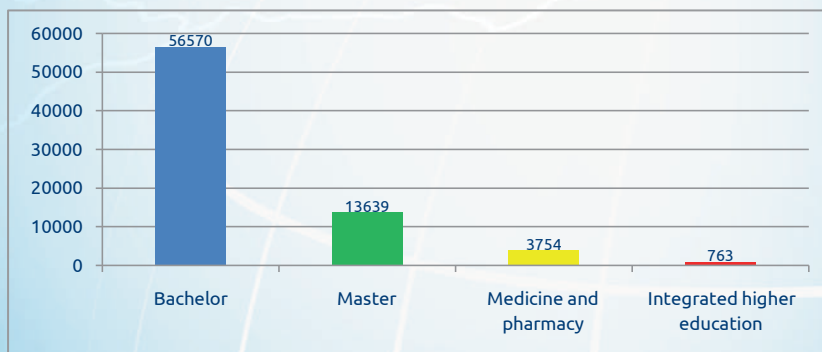

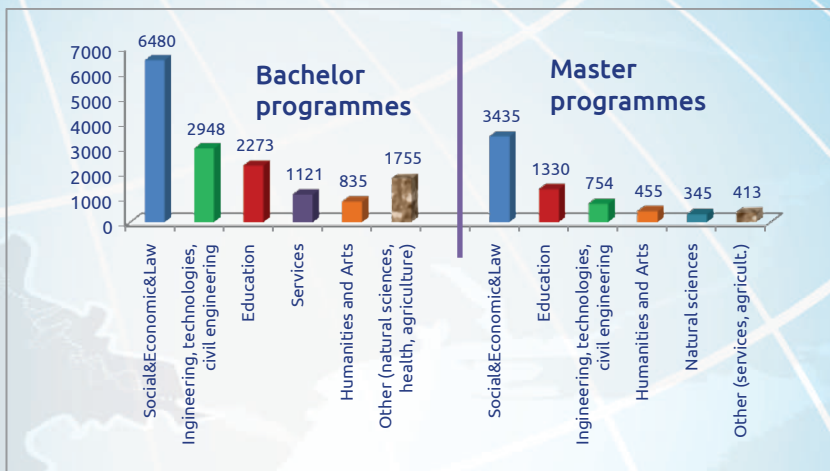
Distribution of students by levels (Bachelor & Master)

Republic of Moldova **joined Tempus in 1994**. From 1994 to 2013 **83 projects** (including pre-projects), worth **in total 43 mln Euro**, were implemented.

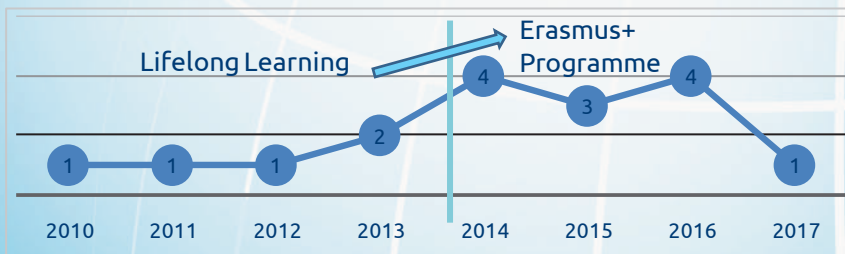
